## Smoke Detector Battery Change

As we all know daylight savings time is fast approaching. Citizens all across this city will be adjusting their time keeping devices this coming Sunday morning-November 2, 2008.

There is one very important change that might just save your life and possibly the life of a family member. That change is the **Battery in your Smoke Detector**. This is an excellent time to make that necessary change.

The Memphis **Fire** Department recommends that citizens change the batteries in their smoke detectors whenever daylight savings time occurs. Take heed to the advice, so that your early warning devices are working properly, especially in the case of an emergency.

The Memphis **Fire** Department urges all citizens to maintain a working smoking detector in their place of residence. Any citizen maintaining a residence within the City of Memphis can apply for a free smoke detector by contacting the Fire Museum of Memphis at (901) 320-5650.
